## Charger Medallion Application – 2018

Corner Canyon High School has a large and diverse student body consisting of students with many differing talents and abilities. The hope is to have students that are well rounded and have participated in many activities. **Only 50 points will be accepted within one particular area**. The focus is to reward participation and not necessarily achievement. **Students may apply during their senior year**. If interested, students can pick up an application for the Charger Medallion from the Student Center and to return the completed application to their counselor.

A student must earn a minimum of **200 points** to qualify for this award. Points can accumulate from 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. The following point values apply to each year of participation at Corner Canyon High School. Activities done at other schools will not be accepted. **Signatures verifying participation from administrators, supervisors, teachers, counselors, and/or coaches from the respective area they supervise are required for each activity.
