

## 2. Fastweb

After the initial sign-up process, you can easily search for scholarships and filter your results based on several data points. Fastweb will also notify you when a new scholarship matching your description is posted and when you have upcoming deadlines.





### 3. College Board

College Board will also automatically match you with eligible scholarships based on the information in your profile. There is also an autofill function, which allows you to reuse information from other scholarship applications, saving you time and helping you apply for more awards.



Applying to scholarships can feel repetitive; that's why Going Merry lets students type in information once and apply for multiple scholarships at the same time. The site also prides itself on including local awards, which are less competitive and may be easier to win than big national scholarships.




## 5. ScholarshipOwl




