Mr. Cram's AP Environmental Science students took advantage of the warm weather last week and held class outside! To better understand how noise pollution interferes with migration patterns, Mr. Cram had his students construct an obstacle course with chairs and had groups guide blinded students through the "migration course." In the first go, the blinded students easily made their way through; however, in the second round, outside students were instructed to be as loud as possible. This greatly prohibited the blinded students from hearing their guides' direction. As one can imagine, the students made It through the migration course much slower the second round!

Ms. Rogers' U.S. History students are studying about the Holocaust this week. It's hard for young minds (or any mind really) to comprehend the enormity of six million lives lost during this tragedy. To help students interact with the content in a more personal way, Ms. Rogers provided each student with a card upon their entry into class. Inside the card, the students found a description of someone who suffered during the Holocaust. Throughout the lesson, Ms. Rogers asked students to think about how their assigned person must have felt and what they must have experienced. At the end of class, Ms. Rogers directed students to read the back of their card, detailing what actually happened to their assigned individual. This was an extremely powerful, emotional way of making history come alive for our CCHS students. We are so grateful for all of your hard work, Ms. Rogers!




