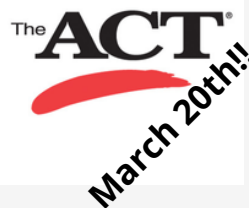

LUNCH AND LEARN

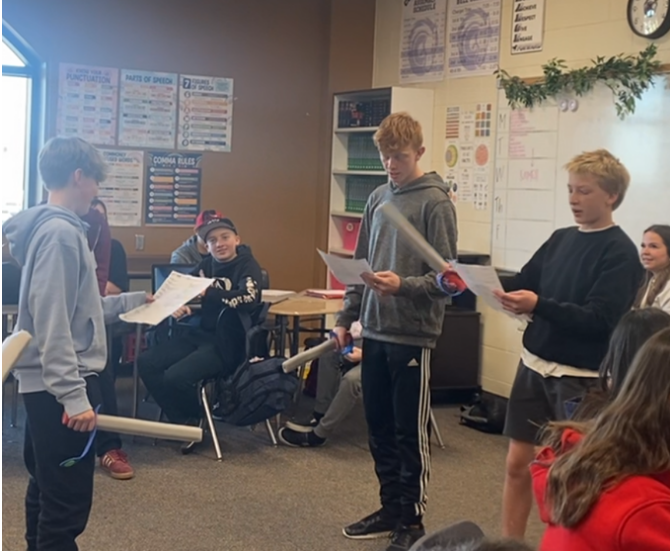
