Mrs. Miller, along with our instructional coach, Jessica Edwards, attended the Math QTEL (Quality Teaching for English Learners) training this past month. This week, the two teamed up and taught Secondary Math I utilizing some of the methods in their QTEL course. This particular lesson introduced symmetry to students by having them sort various patterns and shapes. Students had to rationalize how they grouped the patterns while also comparing and contrasting how their peers labeled different sets of pictures.

### PREP COURSES

In order to provide an opportunity for our students to prepare for the state ACT administration on March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024, the following courses have been scheduled:

MATH COURSE	Ms. Wilson (\$220)	March 4 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup>	3pm-5pm
SCIENCE COURSE	Mr. Jones (\$124)	March 11 <sup>th</sup> and 13 <sup>th</sup>	3pm-5pm

ACT Subject Courses: These classes are designed to review the basics of Math and Science content as well as the format of the ACT test. There will be one course per subject with a minimum enrollment of 10 students and a maximum enrollment of 40 students. Each individual course includes two sessions. The cost is \$15.00 per course. Students are required to pay and register for the course in the main office before March 1<sup>st</sup>. Enrollment in these courses is on a first-come, first-served basis.
