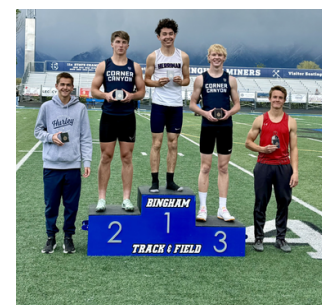

Click Fee Management tab on the left hand side.

If they have fees, you can pay right there (make a payment tab), with a credit/debit card or you/student can come into the main office to pay. 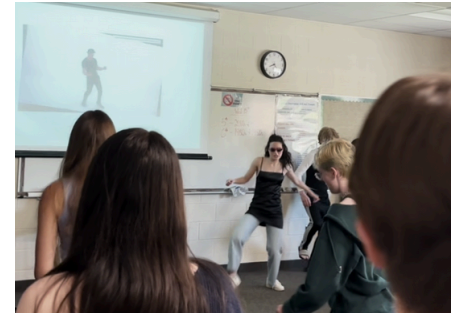

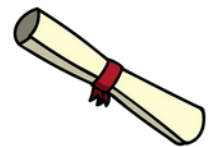
