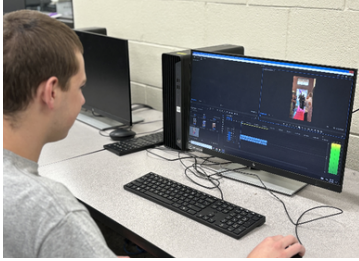
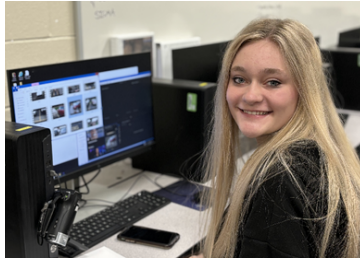
STATE SOLO & ENSEMBLE

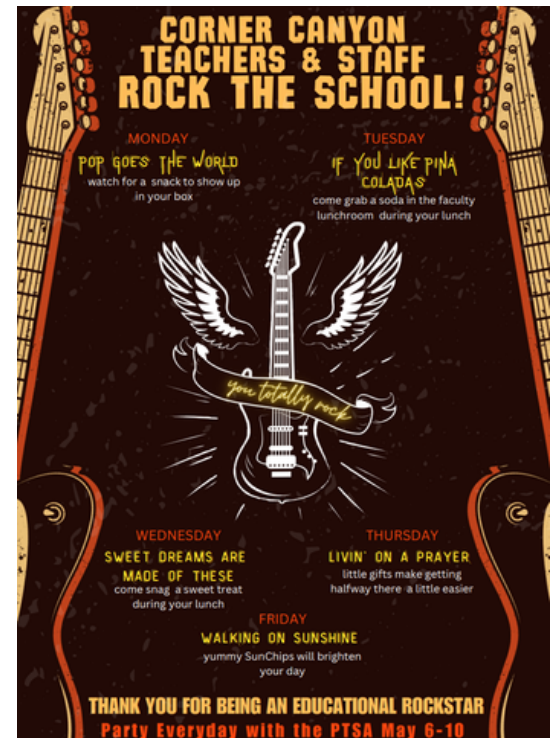
