10th & 11th Grade Students & Parents

We are pleased to announce that Corner Canyon High School will be offering tenth & eleventh grade students the opportunity to take the DIGITAL PSAT/NMSQT again this year!

The test will be administered at Corner Canyon High School at 7:30 AM, on Wednesday, October 30th, 2024. Students will be excused from their 5th and 6th periods on that day. The cost for taking the PSAT/NMSQT is \$21.00. Please register and pay for this using the following Total Registration link prior to September 20th, 2024.

www.TotalRegistration.net/PSAT/450073 A late fee of \$5 will be assessed for students registering after September 20th, 2024. No registrations will be accepted after September 24th, 2024.

This is a national test, consequently this will be the only time that Corner Canyon will be administering this test. There is no make-up date.

One may ask, why should students take the PSAT/NMSQT? It is the best preparation for the SAT Test. Students in tenth grade who take the test can benefit from the practice and be prepared to take it again the next year. Students in eleventh grade who take the test and meet other program entry requirements may qualify for and be considered for the National Merit Scholarship programs. Most importantly, this is a comprehensive tool that gives valuable feedback to both the student and the school and can help all students prepare for the Spring ACT their junior year.
