


With Club Rush behind us student clubs are starting up their activities and meetings. Talk to the teacher advisor for the club you are interested and keep an eye on the school calendar.





Girls Volleyball The team had a fun game this last week working hard together winning against Farmington to the cheers of a very excited student section.






Football
