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1. Welcome – Andrea Lutz, SCC Chair. Motion was made and seconded to start the SCC meeting. Vote was unanimous in favor of beginning the meeting. Reminder was provided for SCC members to check the accuracy of their name and email address on the school website.
2. Minutes – Jeff Colemere.  
Meeting Minutes from November 7, 2024 SCC Meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote.
3. Reading and Math Assessments – Misty Jolley.  
Because reading and math assessment data will not be available until January 16, this agenda item was tabled until the next SCC meeting.
4. Counseling Corner – Michelle Anderson.  
Junior CCRs meetings are nearly all complete (90%). Career assessments for sophomore students have begun. Results will be used in sophomore CCRs in February 2025. Quarterly Senior Silver Star publication was distributed. FAFSA night was held with over one hundred attendees. Counselors also provided counseling to students due to the recent crises at Corner Canyon HS. Counseling focus going forward will be registration and the Charger Fair at the end of January.
5. TSSP and Land Trust – Misty Jolley.  
Misty Jolley led a brainstorming session regarding TSSP and Land Trust planning for next year (2025-26). SCC members requested specific data regarding “F” grades in order to further evaluate progress in the current TSSP and Land Trust goals. Discussions were had regarding multiple language (ML) students at the school and their needs, as well as special education (SPED) students at the school and their needs. The SCC was concerned about balancing the needs of those student groups with the needs of the students as a whole, and about enabling teachers to do their jobs effectively without the burden of additional unnecessary duties.
6. School Information – Dina Kohler.  
The school raised \$170,000.00 for charity this year. Motivation in the form of breakfasts was provided for the highest donating classes. Students also went door-to-door to do odd jobs

in exchange for contributions. Student government did a wonderful job igniting student passion for charity. The Corner Canyon Cheer Team won State. Debate hosted one of the largest debate competitions in the State. ASVAB test was administered successfully. Teachers have been working hard to finalize the semester after the holiday break. Battle of the Bands features 11 bands this year. Numerous students participated in the beautiful memorial of a Corner Canyon student who recently passed away.
