Motion to start meeting at 5:04 - **Approved Unanimously**

1. Welcome

- a. Karen welcomed all to the SCC meeting.

2. Review and Approval of Minutes

3. Digital Citizenship Week Discussion

- a. Digital Citizenship Week - Librarian, Maria Jones, oversees this week. The district puts together the lessons for this. There are lessons happening in the classroom.

5. End of Year Feedback (2024-2025 School Year)

- a. Katie Campbell - F Grade Data Review
 - i. 2026 Quarter 1 Midterm Report
 - 1. Students with F's. Some students have multiple F's
 - a. 9th Grade: 142 students with F's. Total F's 299
 - b. 10th Grade: 171 students with F's. Total F's 334

- c. 11th Grade: 175 students with F's. Total F's 329
 - d. 12th Grade: 153 students with F's. Total F's 258
 - 2. Dina reminded that a lot happens with in the last weeks of the semester
 - 3. Counseling center is working with students who have F's
 - 4. Vanessa, science teacher at CCHS, stated that teachers are not "easing the kids back in" after the summer break. Student learning happens from day 1. All teachers are working with the students to help them improve their grades.
 - 5. Dina reports that when a student misses 5 classes, they are called down to meet with the attendance office. They are reminded how to remove their degree mark - Charger Time.
 - a. Dina stated that some parents are calling to excuse weeks and months of absences for their students so they can make up work.
 - b. Attendance is important and something the school is focusing on.
- b. Katie Campbell - AP Test Score Data for 2024-2025 School Year
 - i. Total tests taken: 1,509
 - ii. Tests Passed: 1,335
 - iii. Pass Rate: 88.5
 - iv. Average Scores: 3.91
 - v. College Credit Hours Equivalency: 8010
 - vi. College Degrees: 66,75
- c. Dina Kohler - School Climate Data
 - i. [Handout](#) Dina shared with all SCC members
 - ii. Students are given a survey and asked questions about the school - Do they feel safe? Do they feel scared?
 - iii. Overall Climate results for CCHS: 79.9% - This is highest in the district! Yay CCHS.
 - iv. Dina stated that she strives for positivity and feeling safe for all students, teachers and staff and is very proud of the Climate Survey.

6. Approval of Safety Plan

- a. Jordan Denos, Assistant Principal, is over CCHS' Safety Plan.
- b. New Laws: Magnets have been removed from all the doors and all the doors need to be locked at all times. There cannot be an obstruction. These locked doors can be difficult for students when they are tardy or leave the class and come back but this is for everyone's safety.
- c. All staff carry the "In an Emergency" Cards and know the protocols.
 - i. Hold! In your room or area. Clear the halls.
 - ii. Secure! Get inside. Lock external school doors.
 - iii. Lockdown! Locks, lights, out of sight.
 - iv. Evacuate! A location may be specified
 - v. Shelter! Hazard and safety strategy

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- d. All classrooms have panic buttons in classrooms
 - i. Trina asked if students know about the panic buttons or how to use them?
Dina reported that the administration is working on a plan for this.
- e. CCHS is constantly working with Draper Police for information and education
administration, teachers and staff need to know
- f. Concerns:
 - i. External Doors being propped open
 - 1. Hall Monitors are constantly removing rocks from doors
 - 2. Hall Monitors are also checking bathrooms
 - ii. Scooter Traffic
 - 1. If a scooter is parked in the wrong place, Mr. Denos is working on a plan to make it so students will need to come talk to the office.
Scooters are hard to ticket - no license plates.
 - 2. Dina reported that the biggest scooter problem is when students are driving their scooters on the sidewalk after school hours.
Please remind your students to follow the rules at all hours on school property.
 - iii. Construction in the new field house
 - 1. New and updated safety plans
 - 2. Original safety routes will return when construction ends on 10/30.
 - iv. Drills and Student Training
 - 1. Draper police have done shooter training with administration
- g. Andrea asked what the plan is when students are congregated together and not in a class (passing period, lunch, etc) and there is a situation that requires a lockdown. Mr. Denos reported that the school can have a safety drill during one of these times.
- h. Voting on Safety Plan - **Unanimously Approved**

- c. Andrea motioned that the Chair, Co-Chair and Secretary meet to update bylaws with recommendations and then send updated bylaws to members for online voting by next Thursday. Seconded. Vote: **Unanimously Approved**
