1. Welcome - Andrea Lutz

2. Review and Approval of Minutes - Janene Day

3. PBIS Data - Katie Campbell

- a. November Charger Card Data for PBIS
 - i. Revenue \$549.75
 - ii. Total Cards Collected (25cents at the store): 2,199
 - iii. Average Collected Weekly 550
- b. December Charger Card Data for PBIS
 - i. Revenue: \$445.00
 - ii. Total Cards Collected: 1,780
 - iii. Average Collected Weekly 445
- c. November Charge Card Drawing
 - i. 4 Jar Options - Airpods, Dance Tickets, CCHS Swag, Parking Ticket
 - ii. 46 Students entered Charger Cards
 1. 36 identifiable teacher names and 103 unidentifiable teacher names (couldn't read their names)

4. Upcoming Student Talk Survey – Katie Campbell

- a. Student Talk PD - Addressing the goal to reduce the number of F's
 - i. Teachers thought this was high-value collaboration with colleagues
 - ii. Teacher suggestions: clarify why students should be referred, smaller groups for more in-depth conversations and create a station where teachers can collaborate on concerns
 - iii. Interventions teachers will use:
 1. Increase communication with parents
 2. Strengthen relationships and personal connections with students
 3. Increase positive interactions and reinforcement
 4. Improve attendance motivation and accountability
 5. Provide clearer expectations, structure, and follow-through
 6. Collaborate more with colleagues
 7. Aim for more individualized support
 - iv. End of Q2 Student Talk Survey - responses for 3-5 individual students from each teacher
 1. Student name
 2. What scaffolds/supports did I offer?
 3. What results did I see?
 4. Was this student discussed during PLC?
 5. Additional support needed?
 - v. Dina commented that this is a large ask and takes a lot of hours from teachers and admin. This was also a community building activity. Teachers have asked to do this again.
 - vi. Dina also commented that best practices were discussed across the board and everyone is working towards moving all students up.
 - vii. Angie Burden commented that the counseling center also attended this PD and it was very beneficial for counselors to be there.

- viii. Katie Campbell also commented that this was a time to get to know colleagues and engage with each other.
- ix. We will have an update on how this is impacting the students with data in a future meeting
- x. Jessica Call commented that an email sent when her student's grade dropped, helped correct what needed to be done to improve the grade
- xi. Timette Wankier asked if there is a way to pull data on the percentage of the F grade. Dina reported they are working on this and it would be helpful for parents to know how to look at grade percentages as well.
- xii. Katie reported that 80% of attendance is the tipping point for a student to be successful in school. Many of our students with F are not coming to class.

5. School Updates – Dina Kohler

- a. Coming back in January is rough - everyone feels and looks like a zombie
- b. December was dedicated to charity month
 - i. Different parts of the school did things to raise money and they raised \$80,000
 - ii. Classroom change collection brought in \$18,200
 - iii. Donation went to Children of the Earth
- c. Travel - We have a lot of teams that travel. It's very beneficial for the students and is a large cost.
 - i. Over the break: Girls Basketball Tournament, Boys Basketball Tournament, Football traveled - national competition in Baltimore
 - ii. Upcoming: cheer - national competition, drill - national competition, debate - debate workshop, wrestling - competition
 - iii. Rules: you can only miss class 2 times, can only be gone 5 days, have to stay within a budget
 - iv. Admin reported that the teachers work well with the students who are traveling.
- d. End of Year Concerts/Mary Poppins Play - students did well and it was a great production and great concerts.

- e. Field House - not totally complete. Ribbon cutting planned for the next month or so. Track, Lacrosse, Soccer, Baseball are starting to use the Field House. PE classes have started using the Field House.
 - i. January 12th at 7pm - Coach Kjar Farewell (took a position at Weber State)
- f. Counselors and Admin have had conversations with students about not feeling like they fit in and Dina wanted to bring it to our attention and know that the school is working on helping all students feel like they have a place
 - i. A counselor has put together a club "The Herd" with the main purpose to reach out and communicate with other students
 - ii. Once a month we have Legislative Council - leaders from every club or organization meet together and this month they discussed how to create a community for all students
 - iii. Admin recognizes that students need an invitation or help to join and get involved
 - iv. Student Body Officers - sit at different tables during lunches with the goal to meet other students
 - v. Dina reported she has an outstanding staff that takes care of each other and looking out for students and taking care of them
- g. Andrea Lutz commented that Admin provided food for families in need for thanksgiving and prior to the Christmas break
- h. PTSA did a Cookie Exchange for the teachers and it was phenomenal

6. Counseling Corner - Angie Burden

- a. Angie reported the counseling center seeing an increased number of students requesting online classes and some of these courses don't require a proctored test. There is concern regarding the quality of the education these online courses will offer
- b. Angie discussed the importance of being in the classroom with the teacher teaching
- c. Dina stated that there is a place for online courses and some students are looking for the "easy way out" for meeting graduation requirements
- d. The counselors are responsible for getting students to graduate and they are still responsible for students when they are taking online
