Registration and fee payment must be completed in person before the first day of class. It is recommended you secure your spot early, classes will fill quickly. Registration forms and payment are to be turned in at the CCHS. *The main office only takes cash or check payments until 2:00 PM.*

The CCHS SUMMER DRIVER ED PROGRAM HAS A NEW FORMAT THIS YEAR.

PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE PACKET CAREFULLY

The summer program this year will be a **hybrid model, part in person and part online.**

Students will be required to attend 5 in-person classes, and will complete the rest of the course online.

There will be two sessions this year. One in June and one in July. There will not be any carry over between sessions. All coursework must be completed in the same session.

June Session Classroom Dates

Day 1: June 1, 8, 17

Day 2: June 2, 9, 18

Day 3: June 3, 10, 22

Day 4: June 4, 11, 23

Day 5: June 5, 16, 24

July Session Classroom Dates

Day 1: July 7, 15, 23

Day 2: July 8, 16, 27

Day 3: July 9, 20, 28

Day 4: July 13, 21, 29

Day 5: July 14, 22, 30

Classroom Sessions: In order to provide flexibility and to accommodate busy summer schedules, multiple classroom dates will be offered. ***Specific content is covered in each class session, so you will need to make sure you can commit to attending each of the in-person classroom days (1-5).*** Students must commit to attending one of each of the 5 classroom dates.

Two classroom sessions will be offered each day. One from 6:00- 9:00 am (AM session) and one from 11:00 am- 2:00 pm (PM session). *Students may choose which session (AM or PM) to attend each day, but attendance at one of the daily sessions is mandatory.* For example, a sample student schedule might look like this:

Day 1: June 1 (6:00-9:00 AM)

Day 2: June 2 (11:00-2:00 PM)

Day 3: June 10 (11:00-2:00 PM)

Day 4: June 29 (6:00-9:00 AM)

Day 5: June 30 (6:00-9:00 AM)

Important: The five dates in this schedule consist of each specific day (1-5). Also, students must have attended the first four days of classroom dates and have all online work done before coming to day 5. Day 5 is the final exam and “check-out” for summer school. Students will check off all of their work and finalize the grade on day 5.

Students must earn a grade of 80% or higher in order to receive credit for the course.

REQUIREMENTS TO PASS THE CLASS AND RECEIVE A COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

Learner Permit: Learner Permits can be obtained from the Drive License Division at the age of 15. To receive a 50 question test, pay a \$19 fee, pass a health questionnaire, pass a vision test, provide your original birth certificate and Social Security card, and show two forms of ID proving that you reside in Utah (i.e. Property Tax Notice, Utility Bill, etc.) The State of Utah requires that an applicant under the age of 18 hold a Learner Permit for six months prior to receiving their driver license. **It is highly recommended that students have their Learner Permit on the first day of class, but it is required that students have their Learner Permit by the time the class is over. Range, road driving and road test times cannot be scheduled if a student does not have a valid permit.**

Pass Hybrid Class with 80% or higher

Driving Range: Students will complete 6 hours of behind-the-wheel training on the student driving range. Range sessions do not have to be completed by the end of the classroom instruction. Range times will be offered throughout the summer. Sign up on the website www.roadscchs.weebly.com Students will sign up for 3 two-hour range sessions that fit their schedule. It is important that students keep their commitment to complete range driving on the days and times they sign up for. Don't sign up for a slot unless you are sure you can attend. Priority for range times will be given to students according to the eligibility date on their Learner's Permit. Students may not sign up for "back to back" range sessions.

Road Driving and Road Driving Test: Students will complete 6 hours of road driving, 3 hours of behind-the-wheel driving and 3 hours of observation. Students will sign up for a road driving test after all of their range and road drives are finished. The road test can't be given by the road driving instructor, it must be a different instructor. The website to sign up is www.roadscchssweebly.com.

NO REFUNDS: Refunds will not be issued for students who fail to meet the attendance requirements or who do not earn 80% or higher in the course.
