1. Welcome - Andrea Lutz

2. Review and Approval of Minutes - Janene Day

- b. Minutes were unanimously approved.

3. School Updates – Dina Kohler

- a. Dina would like to remind SCC members that we can only discuss what is on the agenda. If something is brought up that is not on the agenda, it will need to be moved to next month's agenda.
- b. Dina has had an increased number of emails with questions from parents and she is thinking about having Parent Nights once a quarter next year.
 - i. If you have thoughts or ideas on what she should do, please let her know
 - ii. Janene recommended a virtual option and/or short videos posted that parents and students could watch
 - iii. Dina mentioned having a parent night connected to Parent Teacher Conferences
 - iv. Overall, SCC members thought a Parent Night is a good idea
- c. Dina thanked Katie and the subcommittee for all the work they did on the LandTRUST and TSSP.
 - i. Dina encouraged members to ask any questions they have regarding TSSP and LandTRUST

- d. Celebrations
 - i. Tomorrow is 10 days from the end of the quarter
 - ii. Graduation is 1 quarter away!
 - iii. Dina reminded us that attendance is so important and the students need to be in class. Admin and teachers has been focusing on meeting with students and helping students attend and do well in their classes
- e. Last Teacher Development Day in March
 - i. Admin wants the teachers to have fun and Dina is looking for massage therapists to come in and massage teachers
 - 1. Brenden recommended contacting massage school
 - ii. Dina is looking for suggestions to lighten the load for the teachers
- f. Sterling Scholar - Utah thing and a lot of work
 - i. We had 10 CCHS [Sterling Scholars](#) and 2 have moved to the finals

4. LandTrust/TSSP Plan and Approval

- a. Subcommittee looked at how many credits were earned for credit recovery
 - i. We have ~100 credits and 22 of those credits are specifically in math.
 - ii. All teachers reported that the biggest barrier is attendance - even for credit recovery
- b. **2026-2027 Proposed Goal:** By the end of third quarter of the 2026-2027 school year, CCHS will reduce the total number of F grades among consistently attending students by 8% compared to the 25-26 school year, with a goal of no more than ____ F's. Consistently attending students are defined as those who attend 80% or more of school days.
 - i. Data for missing number of F's will come from the end of 3rd quarter
 - ii. We added an additional 17 hr mentor to focus on 9th graders coming in
 - iii. We added an additional .75 counselor so we can retain our counselor percentage
 - iv. We retained a lot of the classes and teacher support from this year
 - v. Under TSSP we added a one-time amount of \$5,000 for school-wide programs that programs could apply for funds to build up their program (i.e., like The Herd that came to our last meeting)

- vi. TSSP Attendance Tracker, (Kimberly) supports students who are not attending school.
 - 1. Meets with students, calls parents, collects data and reports to administration.
 - 2. She also works closely with counseling center
- c. We currently have 85.5 FTE (Full-Time Equivalent) Employees
 - i. FTE allotted for 26-27: 82
 - ii. We have requested 84 FTE
 - iii. Additional funding from TSSP and LandTRUST helps support salaries and programs
 - iv. We will always be in a deficit and we will continue to find ways to support school needs
 - v. Class requests help determine staffing for non-core classes
- d. Voting on proposed 26-27 goal: Unanimously approved

5. Counseling Corner - Amy Hardcastle for Angi Burden

- b. March is a slower month in the counseling center. The counselors are in the classrooms a lot this month doing more teaching on:
 - i. Financial Literacy
 - ii. Scholarships/Financial Aide
